- Created with high degree of community input
- Upholds Connecticut and New England Traditions
- $\circ~$ Specific to needs and interests of Chester
- Permits a flexible and innovative approach



WHAT A CHARTER ADDRESSES

The Board of Selectmen created the Charter Commission to address issues identified by the Governance Study Committee:

- Increased complexity of the Town's government
- Continuity of executive leadership
- Diffused executive governance authority
- Difficulty recruiting and maintaining professional staff
- Difficulty in finding volunteers to serve and fill vacancies on boards and commissions
- Low Town Meeting participation



PROCESS – NEXT STEPS

- Board of Selectmen have 15 days (April 12 deadline) to provide recommended changes to the Charter Commission for their consideration.
- Charter Commission has 30 days to respond to Board of Selectmen with its final report.
- Board of Selectmen have 15 days after receipt of final report to approve or reject the final proposed charter.
