Minutes of Meeting of March 14, 2022

1. Call to Order

The meeting, held in the Town Hall, was called to order at 7:04 P.M. Members present were Kathy Merola, Bettie Perreault, Rick Schreiber and Whitelaw Wilson. Also present was Marjorie Kagan.

- 2. Request to Review Citations:
 - a. Citation #026-0249 Marjorie Kagan Traveling Unreasonably Fast, Route 148 in area of Camp Hazen-YMCA 57 MPH in 30 MPH zone.

The officer's report of the traffic stop indicated laser recorded speed of 57 MPH in what is a clearly marked 30 MPH zone on Route 148. Ms. Kagan advised she has never been issued a traffic ticket up until that time.
