### **NOMINATION GUIDELINES**

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Nominations for Annual Report Dedication are in recognition of outstanding public and community service to the town, state, and or nation. Individuals and groups are eligible for nomination

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

- 1. **Primary criterion:** The total impact of the nominee's service and accomplishments on the Town of Chester, as well as the state and nation.
- 2. Achievements of an unusually significant nature and their potential effects on the quality of life and economic and social well-being.
- 3. Distinguished service in the general advancement of science and engineering accompanied by substantial contributions to the content of science.
- 4. Recognition by peers within the community.
- 5. Contributions to innovation of services and activities

#### INSTRUCTIONS

Submit nominations via email using the fillable ANNUAL REPORT DEDICATION NOMINATION FORM with letters of recommendation/support included as attachments. Self-nominations are not accepted. A summary of the required nomination information follows.

I. **General Information:** Identification of the nominee. Individuals and groups (Boards, Commissions, Departments, Organizations, and Companies) are eligible for nomination

#### II. Summary of Nominee's Contribution/Achievement

- PROPOSED CITATION FOR CONTRIBUTION/ACHIEVEMENT (Limit 1-2 sentences/50 words). The citation should be a concise statement that highlights the nominee's key contributions/achievements. Note: Fully describe the nominee's contributions/achievements in the Comprehensive Narrative Description
- COMPREHENSIVE NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF CONTRIBUTIONS/ACHIEVEMENTS (Limit 2,000 words, using 12-point type)

#### **III.** Nominee Biographical Information

- PUBLIC/COMMUNITY SERVICE HISTORY: List relevant public/community service history starting from the present with position, board, commission, department, organization, as appropriate
- For an Individual: EMPLOYMENT HISTORY: No more than 10 years required. Chronologically list career positions starting from the present with dates, title, department, organization
- For an Individual: EDUCATION
- LIST OF AWARDS AND HONORS (Limit to 10)
- For a Board, Commission, Department, Organization: Provide institutional history related to this nomination
- **IV. Nominator Information:** Includes identification of the nominator and a statement describing the nominator's relationship to the nominee and contributions/achievements

#### V. Recommendations

- Three letters of recommendation from individuals who have first-hand knowledge of the cited contributions/achievements
- Includes identification of the individual providing each letter of recommendation and a statement describing the individual's affiliation with the nominee
- Format: Electronic Microsoft Word or PDF file
- File Naming Protocol: Last Name of Nominee, First Initial of Nominee-REC-Last Name of Person Writing Letter (For example: Doe, J-REC-Smith)
- Submit Letters of Recommendation as attachments with the Nomination Form
